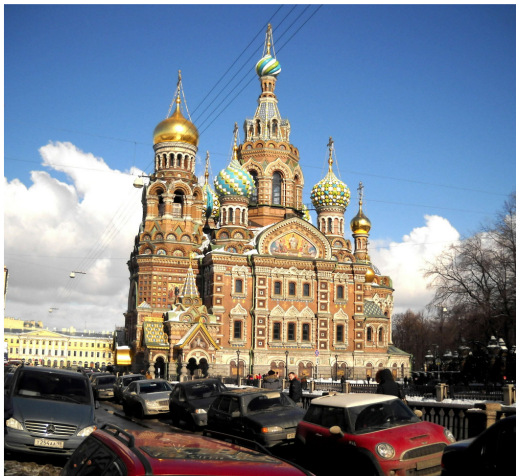

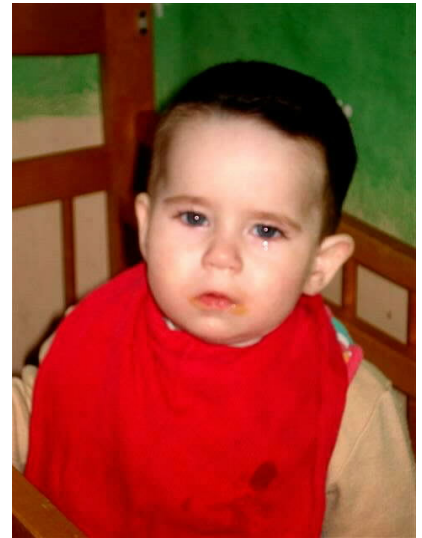

The knit caps were made by ladies in a nursing home in Indiana.



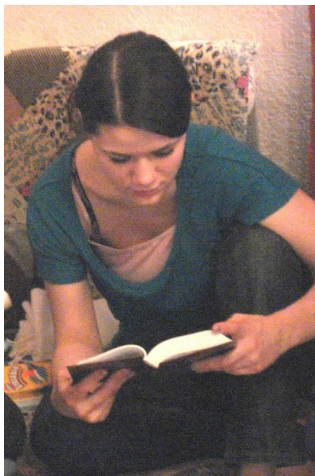
