NOTE: The "mentally challenged" term is used much too frequently there. When children are tested at 7 years of age and react in a way that is other than satisfactory, they are labeled for the rest of their lives. Sadly those children can never overcome that stigma. That is just one of the many bad side effects from 70 years of socialism. I had the pleasure of becoming good friends with many of them. "Dge Dge" (uncle) Marik became my nickname to most of them.

Other activities included a medical mission, a pastors conference, regular church services, working with visiting teams of short-term missionaries & a lot of one on one counseling & prayers. It was a very rewarding time of ministry & by God's grace I was able to minister to many, many children.

My parents, other friends and family and I believe that the Lord has called me, and is preparing me, to serve Him in full-time missionary work as the Director of the children's ministry of "Bibles For Russia." In addition, we believe that Dad needs a "Timothy" to train for future ministry opportunities.
